The Interreg Europe Policy Learning Platform provides a **peer review** service. **Public authorities** can get tailored policy advice to solve a specific **policy challenge**. You can request a peer review at **any time** and on **any topic** covered by the Cohesion policy.

A peer review is a **two-day meeting** with the **Platform experts**, your **local stakeholders** and **selected policy practitioners** from around Europe – your peers. During the meeting, you explain your policy challenges and discuss transferable **good practices**. You team up with peers and experts to jointly prepare **hands-on recommendations** and a **roadmap** adapted to your policy context.

The Platform facilitates the organisation, moderates the content and covers the costs of the peer review. This service aims to provide you with tailored policy solutions to your needs. It is an excellent tool for newcomers external to the Interreg Europe projects to experience the benefits of interregional cooperation!


